- The theme for the Creative Hair Design portion is "Ignite Your Potential." Have a picture of the design that they will do on an 8"x10" photo, and they must use 3 of the 6 elements listed below. No heat is permitted. 2 hours is allotted for this portion. A dollar limit on supplies will be \$10 and cannot exceed that amount, you must provide a receipt to prove the amount.
 - 1. Embellishments (beads or hoops)
 - 2. Option of color weave in or any color extension
 - 3. Multiple strand braid
 - 4. Finger waves (no heat, must use a product to accomplish)
 - 5. Up-do
 - 6. May use temporary spray color
