	Field Assignment: The assignment evaluates the competitor's creative ability and adherence to competition guidelines. Competitors are brought to an					
	undisclosed location to capture images based on a theme chosen by the contest					
	coordinator. Competitors will then choose their best images and apply global					
	edits and light editing before producing a contact sheet for judging. Scoring is					
	based on:					
	• Technical: exposure and focus control					
	 Creative: overall use of composition, lighting, impact, etc. 					
	 Level of editing (edits must be global in nature and must not be overdone) 					
	 Competitor's adherence to time limits, location and theme 					
	Conceptual Assignment: Competitors will use Adobe Photoshop to combine a					
	minimum of three images from their chosen field assignment to produce a					
	creative conceptual piece of art. Very few parameters are put on this competition, as it is meant to evaluate creativity.					
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	Digital Editing: Competitors will be given images to manipulate in Adobe					
	Photoshop. This competition evaluates the student's knowledge of professional					
	editing techniques, including, but not limited to:
