- Contestants are NOT permitted to have reference manuals for their selected software programs[s]during the contest.
- Additional software allowed for support files [NOT TO BE USED FOR PRIMARY LAYOUT PURPOSES]: Adobe Photoshop, Adobe Illustrator, Macromedia Freehand and Painter.

Computer portion of the contest

 Contestant will need to know how to do a page layout which includes placing items from a disk, doing color separations, sizing, text wrap, reverse, crop, scale, rotate, etc.
