## Manikin Head - Braiding portion of contest:

(No off-site braids on head)

Manikin will be sectioned into two halves of the head.

One half of the head is Box Braids, the other half is Cornrows.

#### Box Braids:

- Minimum is 1" x 1"
- Length is maximum of 18"
- No heat (burning melting) only rubber bands at the ends
- Synthetic hair only (no pre-color only natural as the manikin comes)
- Extension color must match the color of manikin

#### Cornrows:

- Minimum of 4 cornrows must be on the head
- No heat (burning / melting) only rubbers bands at the
- Synthetic hair only (no pre-color only natural as the manikin comes)
