Contact with Contest Coordinators outside of the SkillsUSA Ohio is strictly prohibited.</li> <li>Possession of smart watches and/or phones during the contest and/or in contest.</li> <li>Contact with anyone outside of the contest area once the contest begins.</li> <li>Inappropriate communication between contestants such as verbally degrading another contest.</li> <li>Cheating on any portion of the contest such as informing another contestant of the skills/test prior to competing.</li> <li>Lack of Copy Emergency Medical Form in Name Badge.</li> </ul>
