Contest	The technical skill performance tasks will assess skills in facial cleansing massage (15 minutes), basic facial (30 minutes), and beauty makeup application (60			
Contest	minutes). Technique is scored in the performance tasks of facial massage, basic			
	facial and beauty makeup application. An emphasis on safety and health will be			
	used in all segments of the skill performance areas. Observations during each			
	segment and evaluation of the finished product will be considered in the scoring.			
	The competition rules will be reviewed at the orientation. At the orientation,			
	competitor will submit written theme in a plastic sheet and 4"x 6" or larger			
	full face BEFORE picture (printed) of model. Color prints preferred.			
	All competitors must always keep their working area clean and organized.			
	All competitors must follow sanitation and safety procedures throughout the			
	competition.			
	All competitors must bring a model for the orientation and competition.			
	Competitors will prepare and perform an oral communication presentation.			
	This will consist of a two- to three-minute oral presentation of an analysis of			
	the skin and client consultation. Competitor will be given a skin type and			
	should be able to recommend a skin care treatment and home care regimen.			
	Penalty points can occur for the following:			
	 Leaving the competition area before completion of task (applies to both competitor and model) without proper escort. 			
	Any product used that is not as manufacturer intended.			
	Any product discussified as manufacturer interfacture. Any product that appears to have been altered or not properly identified.			
	with the manufacturer's original packaging and original labeling.			
	Working after time is called.			
	Cell phones or other forms of communication technology are not to be in the			
	competition area. If models and/or competitors are using any digital			
	communication device competitor will be disqualified.			
	Conversation between competitor and model is limited. Any form of			
	communication with observers, judges and other competitors is prohibited			
	during the competition and may be grounds for disqualification.			
	All times are approximate and will be confirmed during orientation.			
	Supplied by the Technical Committee at the Contest Site: Contestant chair,			
	Models Chair (upright, NOT a facial chair), Shared product table, two teams			
	per table and one shared steamer for heating towels will be provided. Electricity is available if contestants bring their own heating equipment such

No piercing, earrings or necklaces that interfere with the services provided. **Provided by** • Professional Resume' (Present at Check-In Table) - typed hardcopy Contestant • Emergency Medical Form (Contestants must have this to compete) • Model and full face BEFORE picture (printed) of model. NO MAKEUP Typed, brief but specific, description (10-50 words) of the beauty makeup application. Small trash bag (tape will be provided) Writing utensil. • The contestant is responsible for their supplies. They should present their kits with enough supplies in a sanitary condition. Only the following items should be in the kit; anything else must be removed prior to entering the contest floor. Esthetics kit items must be in the original manufacturer's packaging. Judges need to be able to determine what type of product is being applied. All items necessary for basic facial and massage (cleaner, toner, moisturizer, exfoliator, mask and massage cream.) All items necessary for beauty makeup application, USE SPATULAS and palettes. • All necessary product applicators such as: spatulas, cotton swabs, fan and mask brushes, cotton 4x4 pads or sponges, tissues, mascara wands, makeup brushes. All applicators must be disposable or disinfected. • Eyelashes, adhesives, tweezers, scissors and necessary application tools with alcohol wipes and sanitizers. • A minimum of six (6) white terry towels (no holes/stains). A warmer will be provided. • Headband. • Proper draping supplies. • Plastic bags for sanitation and solid linens. • At least two (2) pairs of gloves (latex free preferred.) • Paper towels and tissues. • Decontamination supplies for hands, equipment and implements (must be EPA approved for salon and spa use) AND USE IT! Disinfectant packed away in the kit throughout the contest draws an automatic deduction for improper sanitation IN EACH SEGMENT. • Blood spill kit must have a biohazard bag and be properly labeled. First aid kit by itself is NOT acceptable. Towel bowl (1 ½ quart minimum) • Portable kit Organizer (travel suitcase, rolling tool kit or similar)
