Scope of Contest	 The competition will include activities that simulate situations encountered by criminal investigation professionals. See appendix below for examples. Each competitor team must work independently without assistance from instructors, other teams, or observers. Any violation of this may disqualify the competitor. Cell phones, iPads/tablets, smart watches, wearable technology, or any other electronic communication device is prohibited in the competition area. Only competitors, judges and event staff are allowed in the competition area at any time. Observation is limited to the area designated by the judges or event staff. Outdoor competition area may only be accessed by judges, competitors, and event staff. Any violation of this may disqualify the competitor. No one may contact judges in any way and at any time without the expressed permission of the competition coordinator.

Provided by Contestant	 Professional Resume – must be typed and physically produced as a hard copy Emergency Medical Form (Contestants must have this to compete) Crime scene kit containing materials necessary to conduct a crime scene investigation, e.g., fingerprint cards, brushes, powder, crime scene tape, etc. Small pocket notebook for field notes Pens and pencils Handcuffs and handcuff case Flashlight Digital camera (any style – quality of photography will not be judged) Safety glasses with side shields or goggles (prescription glasses with side shields. If not, they must be covered with goggles). Note: Safety eyewear must be available, but use will depend on the scenario
